Singapore Summer Study Tour – Registration Open

Thank you to all parents who participated in the preliminary interest survey! Based on feedback, Singapore emerged as the most popular destination. To help broaden our students' international perspectives, we plan to customize a study tour program for YIA students in partnership with the professional organization, ASDAN.

****University Classes:**** Visit Nanyang Technological University and the National University of Singapore (ranked 8th and 12th globally in the QS World University Rankings). Students will attend classes led by PhD candidates on the themes of Artificial Intelligence and Robotics.

****Company Visits:**** Tour Alibaba Cloud International Headquarters, Westen Robot, and True World Studios, where students will engage in face-to-face discussions with industry experts.

****City Exploration:**** Discover iconic landmarks such as the Merlion, Singapore City Gallery, Marina Barrage, and the Sustainable Singapore Gallery to learn about urban planning and sustainable development.

****Cultural Experiences:**** Create traditional UNESCO-recognized batik art and explore the rich heritage of Chinatown.

****Special Experiences:**** Enjoy a night safari at the Night Safari and witness the spectacular light show at Gardens by the Bay.

****Dates:**** June 22–27, 2026 (6 days, 5 nights)

****Location:**** Singapore

****Minimum Group Size:**** 15 participants

****Cost:**** - 15 participants: RMB 27,800 per person - 20 participants: RMB 25,800 per person

****Program Organization:**** This program will be independently organized and operated by ASDAN. The school will not be involved in the specific itinerary arrangements.
