ATTENDANCE POLICY

Parents should contact National Advisory Teacher by 8:00 am on the day your child will be unable to attend. The reason for the absence should also be given at this time. Students who arrive at school after 8:00 am must check in with the Lobby Receptionist before they will be admitted to class. If a student arrives after 10:00 am, he/she will be counted a 1/2 day absent. Those who arrive after 12:30 pm. will be counted absent for a full day.

• Excused absences include illness, death in the family, and pre-approved family events. Upon their return to school, students will have two school days to make up each missed day's work.

Secondary students who are absent for more than three days in a quarter must bring a doctor's note to school; otherwise, the absence will be considered unexcused.

- For unexcused absences, a student will receive a zero for every assignment or test falling on that day and will also be ineligible for after-school activities on that day. An unexcused absence on Friday will result in the student not being eligible for weekend activities.
- Planned absence approval by the principal must be requested at least one week in advance in writing by the parents, stating clearly the reason for the request. Any activity that can be taken care of during non-school hours will not be considered an acceptable reason for a planned absence. In order for students to receive credit for classes missed during a family vacation, prior notification must be received. Teachers may require work to be done in advance, or set dates for work to be turned in at a later date. These details should be worked out with the student's teacher(s).

Chinese Spring Festival is one of the most important holidays in China. At YIA, we encourage students to stay rooted in Chinese culture and think globally. In order to enhance students' Chinese cultural literacy, we demonstrate Chinese cultural characteristics through various forms of activities e.g. China Week activities.
