Enjoy Water Safely

This announcement is designed to proactively raise awareness of water safety ahead of summer outdoor activities.

1. **Supervision is rule #1.** Kids must be watched whenever they're around water, no matter what their swimming skills. This is true whether the water is in a bathtub, a wading pool, an ornamental fish pond, a swimming pool, a spa, an ocean, or a lake. Even kids who know how to swim can be at risk for drowning. For instance, a child could slip and fall on the pool deck, lose consciousness, and fall into the pool and possibly drown.
2. Young children are especially at risk. They can drown in less than 2 inches (6 centimeters) of water. That means drowning can happen in a sink, toilet bowl, fountains, buckets, inflatable pools, or small bodies of standing water around your home, such as ditches filled with rainwater. Young kids and weak swimmers should have an adult swimmer within arm's reach to provide "touch supervision."
3. Look out for lifeguards. If you're looking for a place to cool off always find a lifeguarded swimming site.
4. Currents in the water can be very strong. If you find yourself caught in a rip tide – don't swim against it – you'll tire yourself out. Swim with the current and call for help.
